



Tryout Procedure and Guidelines
Rep Tryouts for Mosquito, Pee wee, Bantam, and Midget Divisions
AAA /AA/A

1. Combined Skills Evaluation Sessions:

- There will be two (2) skill evaluation sessions for each division.
- All those trying out for Rep are to attend the Combined Skills Evaluation Sessions.
- There will be a minimum of three (3) Board Appointed Evaluators at each session.
- There will be a minimum of three (3) on-field helpers at each session.
- Following the Skill Evaluation Sessions, ALL players will be ranked based on the Board Appointed Evaluator's Assessment.
- Player cuts may be made following the Combined Skill Evaluation Sessions.

2. Tryout Game Evaluations:

Those player's moving on from the Combined Skills Evaluations Sessions will be separated into two (2) groups:

Group 1 – AAA Game(s):

- This group will be comprised of the top ranked players wishing to be considered for AAA. These rankings are based on the Combined Skill Evaluation Sessions. This group will be comprised of a minimum 18 players.
- The top six (6) players based on the Combined Skill Evaluation Sessions will be placed on the AAA team.
- The AAA Head Coach will evaluate this game to determine the final 6 or 7 selections of the AAA team.
- This game(s) must take place at least two (2) days prior to the Group 2 – AA Game(s).

Group 2 – AA Game(s):

- This group will be comprised of the remaining players from the Combined Skill Evaluation Sessions, plus those players who have been released from AAA consideration following the Group 1 – AAA Game.
- The next six (6) top ranked players based on the Combined Skill Evaluation Sessions will be placed on the AA team.
- The AA Head Coach will evaluate this game to determine the final 6 or 7 selections of the AA team.

***Group 3 – A Game(s): *If required**

- *If there are enough players to warrant a third rep team ('A' Team) in any Division, a third game (Group 3 – A Game) will be played using the same format above.*

Note: All policies and procedures herein are subject to change based on player numbers, weather, field and volunteer availability etc.

UPDATED KVMBA Tryout Policy Update:

KVMBA's goal is to field the best teams as possible at the rep level. To ensure proper player development and overall association strength, we strive to ensure players are positioned at the appropriate level which their skills and abilities dictate.

Our process currently involves the KVMBA board selecting the top 6 performing players and the coach selecting the remaining 6 players, both at AAA and again at the AA and when a third team is involved in a division, at the A level.

Players may choose to opt out of consideration for AAA and only be considered for the AA or A level. However, if a player does opt out of consideration for AAA, they will not be eligible to be selected by the KVMBA board at the AA or A level. Their selection to the AA or A team will be at the discretion of the AA or A coach.

If a player wishes to opt out of consideration for AAA, they must advise their respective Division Coordinator, in writing via email, prior to taking the field for tryouts.
